world”...

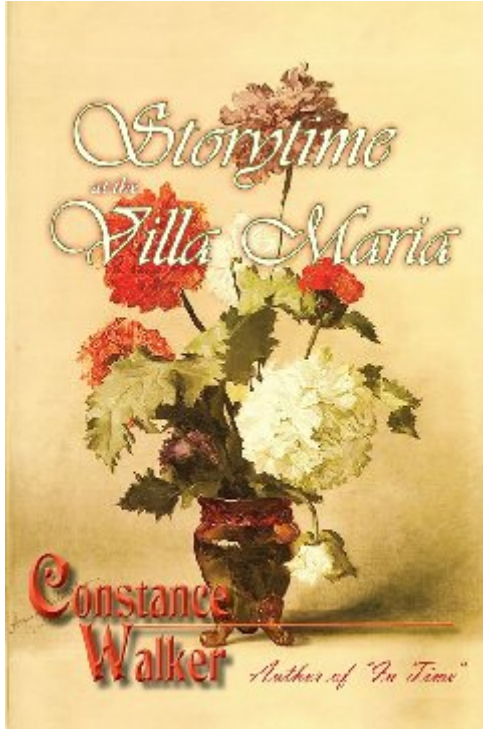
Sophie, who is haunted by terrifying memories of the
